JULY 15 MEMORY
 ABOUT YOU THE TALE YOU WILL SEE!



The July 15 Memory built as a symbol of our nation's epic struggle against the coup attempt on July 15, 2016, that was organized by the Fethullahist Terrorist Organization (FETO) / Parallel State Structure (PDY). The July 15 Memory, which opened its doors to visitors in 2019, continues to serve in cooperation with the July 15 Association under the Ministry of Culture and Tourism since 2020.

The July 15 Memory, whose content was determined as a result of a comprehensive workshop held on 7 January 2017 by the Ministry of Culture and Tourism, IMM and the July 15 Association, was implemented under the auspices of the Presidency of the Republic of Turkey and curated by the architect Muharrem Hilmi Şenalp.

The July 15 Memory covers a wide period from the coups in Turkey and the world, especially the July 15, to the history of colonialism in a holistic way through visual and audio materials.

In the hall where many representations ranging from the video narration of the events on the night of the coup attempt to the personal belongings of the martyrs and veterans are found, it is possible to see the shoes borrowed from the families of the martyrs, the vehicle crushed by the tank in front of the General Staff Building, the beret and wedge of Martyr Ömer Halisdemir, and the mobile phone of to the journalist Hande Fırat, through which President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan invited the public to the squares. In addition, digital kiosks provide information about the martyrs of July 15 and the countries that have been subjected to coups or colonialism in different geographies of the world.

In the section on the mechanism of colonialism, the stages of imperialism throughout history are revealed and it is aimed to raise awareness of the younger generations on the colonial mentality.

It is composed of 12.000 square meters of usable area, Martyrs' Road with 251 cypress trees planted in the name of martyrs, Martyrs' Respected Post and July 15 Memory building, which has a representative architectural feature. In addition, there is the Şüheda Mosque to the west of the building.
